COVID-19 Customer Guidelines

Updated 1 June 2020

Following the latest COVID-19 guidance from the Government, Farnham Park Baseball & Softball Complex has been allowed to re-open. In order to ensure the safety of our customers and staff, **ALL** softballers and baseballers must follow the terms and conditions of play outlined below. Farnham Park Terms and Conditions of Play

- All Government guidelines (available [here](#)) must be followed
- Fields must be booked in advance. Please do not come to Farnham Park without reserving a space
- Do **NOT** come to the facility if you are experiencing any of the following:
 - High temperature
 - A new, continuous cough
 - Loss or change to your sense of smell or taste
- Do **NOT** play baseball/softball if you have been told to self-isolate by the NHS
 - This includes any quarantine, or if you have been contacted by the Track and Trace programme
 - If a member of your household is experiencing COVID-19
- Sessions can involve catching, fielding or hitting with up to, but no more than, five other people are permitted
- Physical contact with anyone outside your household is not permitted, therefore playing of any games (small sides or full) is not permitted at this time
- Do not use the dugouts on any field, they should only be used to access the field
- Social distancing is required at all times. Per Government guidelines, this means staying two metres apart from any other person
- Play safe. Please try to limit the risk of injury, in order to keep pressure off the NHS
- Do **NOT** join up with another group
- Use the provided hand sanitiser at each field; if possible, bring your own
- Keep equipment sharing to a minimum
- If equipment is shared, please use the wipes provided to wipe down the equipment after every use
- Please be aware of other park users around the site – there may be more than usual
- Only one person may use the toilet facilities at a time

Further, the following guidelines apply to Home Plate Bar & Kitchen:

- Follow all social distancing signage, ensuring that you are two metres apart
- Please try to pay with a contactless card, if possible
- No congregating outside of Home Plate; all food and beverages must be taken away from the clubhouse
- Only one person should order for any group
- Per Government advice, wearing a face covering while ordering is strongly encouraged

SOCIAL DISTANCING KEEPING MUST BE ADHERED TO AT ALL TIMES – PLEASE STAY 2 METRES APART

All members of staff, including groundskeepers, have full authority and responsibility to ensure that play on the course is carried out within the acceptable COVID-19 Guidelines from the Government, and in line with the terms above. If you do not follow the guidelines you may be asked to leave the facility.
