Coaching Playbook Objectives




To design a coach development pathway that:

Activator Award and Introduction to Coaching Award



We aim to set up and deliver two forms of introduction courses: -

- o Introduction to Coaching will be the starting point on a coaches journey. This will provide the coach with the basics of coaching to support a lead coach before taking their next step to the CORE Coach Qualification.
- Activator Award provide Activators the tools to facilitate fun and engaging activities in various playing environments. The Activator workshop will provide you with the opportunity to learn the rules of baseball and softball, the basic technique and some fun and engaging game ideas. It will also give you some tips to ensure inclusivity, allowing everyone to participate regardless of their age, gender, health or ability.

Delivery – both the 'Introduction to Coaching Award' and 'Activator Award' will be delivered via 'face-to-face' learning or via eLearning.

Phase 1 – eLearning Introduction to Coaching Award

CORE COACH QUALIFICATION



Stands for Coaching, Organisation, Responsibility and Engagement

Develop soft skills (communication, empathy, listening, questioning) and create player-centered strategies.

Planning and executing training sessions efficiently; manage resources and time.

Emphasize safeguarding and supportive coaching.

Techniques to foster player motivation and inclusivity.

What to Coach: Technical skills (e.g., throwing, hitting, defensive strategies).

How to Coach: Soft skills (e.g., communication, inclusivity, leadership).

Course Purpose

- Equip coaches with the fundamentals for all pathways:
- Youth Participation, Talent Development, Adult Recreation/Competitive, or Performance.



To achieve this, we use a series of accessible methods and tools that brings high quality learning and development to the coach!




