

BSUK Facilities guidance off-field



STORAGE

A few clubs in the UK have the luxury of a clubhouse for storing their equipment, many use storage containers or sheds instead. This could also depend on how secure your venue is.

We recommend you search online at the time of purchase as prices may vary depending on the size required and local availability.

Exeter Baseball Club obtained a 20ft x 8ft container at an approximate cost of £2500 plus £300 delivery in 2019.

Worcester Baseball Club purchased a metal shed in 2022 for \pounds 360 from a local supplier.

BACKSTOP AND FENCING

A 20ft high backstop is recommended for adult baseball, depending on your club's grounds, you may need a higher backstop if there are buildings or carparks nearby.

Similarly, a fastpitch backstop can be 20ft in height or 10ft straight with panels at a 45-degree angle on top.

Perimeter and foul line fences are advised at 1.2m high.

We have had quotations in 2020 from **www.agripower.co.uk** for our Farnham Park facility

6m high backstop, fenced dugouts and roofs, 2 x foul line fences (1.2m) (no outfield fence) – \pounds 22,633.30 + VAT

6m high backstop, fenced dugouts and roofs, 1 x foul line fence (1.2m) – \pounds 19,479.34 + VAT

6m high backstop, fenced dugouts and roofs - £16,325.38 + VAT

Based on these quotations, we would expect an outfield fence of 1.2m high to be circa \pounds 4-5k.



LINE MARKERS

For the job of marking the lines on the field, whether you are doing width 5cm (2 inches) or 10cm (4 inches) lines, you may want to get yourself some good marking equipment like the ones in the links below or you can make your own equipment with some planks and a can, buy your chalk and away you go.

Below you can see a selection of the readily available bases styles which you can use in your field design. You may purchase these from various shops in the UK and abroad.

Portable (throw down) rubber bases

Great for indoors and outdoors, easy to carry. Not good with high grass: **https://bit.ly/3F88oHd**

Vinyl coated (pillow) base set

Best for grass fields, really easy to set up and carry: https://bit.ly/3Y63F1k

Hollywood Safe slide bases

These are easy to install and can be move to different locations: https://bit.ly/3VWc5GJ

Holliwood bases (anchored)

These have a permanent fixing to your field: https://bit.ly/3iHc7UH

POP-UP STYLE



Whether your club is new and not ready yet for a permanent backstop, planning permission is needed for a solid structure or finances don't currently allow for it, the two options below will allow your club to set-up a backstop for game-day.

Stop That Ball[™] system

With removable steel ground sockets. The durable ball stop net is ideal for baseball and softball. **Height:** 3.7m **Lengths available:** 3m, 6m, 9m, 12m, 15m. **Price approx:** £150 (3m length)

Ball Stop Net and Post System

With removable ball stop post & net system, including sockets, pulleys, deats and hauling ropes. **Heights:** 3.7m, 6m or 8m **Length:** 5m – 150m **Price approx:** £1,300 (6m x 20m)



Baseball and Softball 'Panel and Post system'

A readily available solution for baseball and softball backstops in the UK. This system is popular in schools and Multi Use Games Areas (MUGAs).

Your club is ready to set base and have all the planning permits needed to construct a solid backstop, the First Fence style option will allow you to begin constructing a backstop which is right for your sport. This modular build will allow you to add on to your fence as your club needs grow.

Height: starting at 1.2 metres up to 3 metres high. Posts come 1 metre longer than the final height to allow for a strong, buried foundation

Lengths available: Flexible

Price approx: First Fence quoted £1,612 for the materials for a backstop shown, including £130 for delivery to Manchester. All screws, plastic inserts, security bolts are included. They also supplied the post concrete to which you simply add water.

Delivery: Available for £130 to Birmingham, Dartford, Bristol, Bradford and Glasgow

Installation: The panels are easily installed once the posts have been planted. A handy member of your club should be able to install the backstop. You may choose to get a quote from a local builder.
